Since 2001, the LAC Summit has been providing a non-partisan unparalleled educational opportunity for elected state and provincial officials with an interest in agriculture and rural communities to work together, network, collaborate and create problem solving partnerships.

This is an invitation-only Summit, and all of your on-site expenses (room, registration and meals) are covered by State Agriculture and Rural Leaders, a federal 501 c(3) non-profit. There are also travel scholarships for those without state or campaign funds for transportation.

You can fly into the New Orleans airport and take a super shuttle to Baton Rouge or fly into Baton Rouge. You might even want to spend an extra day or two taking in the sites of southern Louisiana.

We always begin the Summit with some site visits of regional agriculture. In Baton Rouge that includes an optional visit to a grain export elevator on Thursday afternoon, crawfish and catfish, Angola prison and a gator farm. You can not participate in all of these and will have to make choices.




The Legislative Agriculture Chairs Summit is designed for state and provincial legislative committee, caucus and chamber leadership with an interest in agriculture and rural policy.
